BE A W.E.S.T. KIND OF PERSON

An interesting chat between myself, Mitch, Jason and Greg has been shared by MJRers this week after Mitch shared his thoughts on using the E for ENCOURAGING from W.E.S.T.

Mitch wrote 'When I am introducing MJR to the various schools I mention W.E.S.T.. When it comes to 'Encouraging', I ask if the whole class can name me 10 "Encouraging words. Most classes struggle to get 10. I then say, if you don't know Encouraging words, how can you use them?

It could be a helpful 10 minutes to spend with your class to list some "Encouraging" words, so that as a class and school, you can start to fill peoples' buckets. This activity can really increase the <u>Spirit of Jesus</u> in your classes and school. Try to get 25.

Another 3 questions I ask them is:

- When was the last time you encouraged your parents? Watch the look of amazement on their faces.
- When was the last time you encouraged your brothers and sisters? More amazement.
- When was the last time you encouraged a teacher and Principal? Complete amazement!!

We all know as teachers, **Encouraging** others leads to happy lives, as we are giving happiness to others by building them up, which is what the <u>Spirit of Jesus</u> is all about. On the other hand, constant put downs comes from a negative mindset, that can only lead to unhappiness in the people around us. We all can do with plenty of **Encouragement**.

Marty then added that when doing the S for SORRY, we take for granted that the students REALLY know what Sorry means. They often talk about saying sorry/apologising or forgiving, but don't get that Sorry really means that we are going to TRY and not do it again. This needs to be reinforced over and over again.

Greg then added, "What's also important is that if someone says 'sorry', and in the true context that means, I'm sorry I hurt you, I'm sorry I upset you and I'll try and not do that again. What is also very important, is that those receiving the apology don't just say 'That's ok!', because it's not. Maybe the better response may be 'I forgive you! But please don't do it again I don't like it....you hurt me...that was mean...' The forgiveness word is a welcoming word, one that says, even though you've hurt me, you're still my friend."

Finally, Jason added, ask the kids to write, 'Sorry is an action' on their page and discuss. Too often the word is just a cop out, so they can move on, rather than something that they 'do'.

Apart from the bad weather and the sadness that the second day was cancelled, it has been extremely informative to get your views on what you enjoyed, what you found useful and what we could improve.






