## SOJ Lesson WHAT DO WE HAVE IN COMMON?

## WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- Spirit of Jesus Books
- Something to play YouTube videos
- 1. Have everyone get in groups of three and stand in a circle.
- 2. Tell the students their assignment for the next two minutes is to find five distinctive things that the three of them have in common. The three things cannot be school related or obvious i.e. all are girls.

Examples:

- All born in the same city
- All have two siblings
- All have a parent who was born overseas.
- 3. Have the first groups that finish sit down.
- 4. When the two minutes are up, select three groups to introduce themselves and find out what they have in common.
