







## (Vale Pope Francis 1936 - 2025

With the passing of Pope Francis, I felt it would be a great time to revisit his wonderful contribution of bringing HOPE to a world that is badly in need of positivity.

He had a simple message that young people especially appreciated. His message was that of opening our arms to all, nurturing change, and putting into action the message of Jesus.

It is amazing how closely Pope Francis and the MJR philosophy aligned.

This connection between Pope Francis & MJR is easly seen when examining Pope Francis's post-synodal Apostolic Exhortation on the Gifts and Challenges of Family Life, Amoris Laetitia - The Joy of Love: On Love in the Family (2016).

In this, Pope Francis stated:

264 .... (we need) active methods and a dialogue that teaches through sensitivity and by using a language children can understand.

266. Good habits need to be developed. A person may be sociable and open to others, but if over a long period of time he has not been trained by his elders to say 'Please', 'Thank you', and 'Sorry', his good interior disposition will not easily come to the fore...

267 ... Moral education has to do with cultivating freedom through ideas, incentives, practical applications, stimuli, rewards, examples, models, symbols, reflections, encouragement, dialogue and a constant rethinking of our way of doing things; all these can help develop those stable interior principles that lead us spontaneously to do good.

In MJR, we continually push the need to develop good habits (eg WEST), the art of reflection, and the encouragement of using language that transmits into positive action. This is very similar to the quotes from Amoris Laetitia mentioned. Plus, Pope Francis's 2025 Jubilee Year 'Pilgrims of Hope' also aligns with the MJR ethos.


Much has and will be written about His Holiness, but his connection to the poor, the planet, and to children must be highlighted.


May he rest in peace. Because, PEACE is what Pope Francis continually sought for the underprivileged and deprived.
























#### POPE LEO XIV




