No doubt, like you all, I was absolutely rapt about the surviving and rescue of the 'Wild Boar' Soccer team.

With the world news of wars, violence, poverty etc. that tends to get us upset, and with so much news that divides us, it makes us wonder

where the world is heading. Then along comes a story that unites the whole world.

We hoped and prayed for a miracle, and it happened. It united the whole world like nothing else has in recent times.

There were so many of the wonderful human qualities we talk about in MR evident in this story. The whole story could be summed up as, 'this is how life can be so much better, if we lived the Spirit of Jesus'. I will mention a few to get you and your class started and I am sure you and your class will come up with so many more ...

- Team work makes the dream work.
- Being a 'Giver' of your talents to help others.
- **Self-discipline** and the mental toughness of all concerned, including the coach and the 12 boys nine days in darkness and no hope or food (devices etc.).
- Gratitude shown by the team to the rescuers and Navy Seals.

- Positive thinking and having a go.

There would be other qualities that could be a great exercise for your class to think about:

- Ask how they would feel being in the cave.
- Ask them if they think that this is a gospel story. The "Gospel happens every day in the little things we say and do. 'Get **SWITCHED ON TO THEM**".
